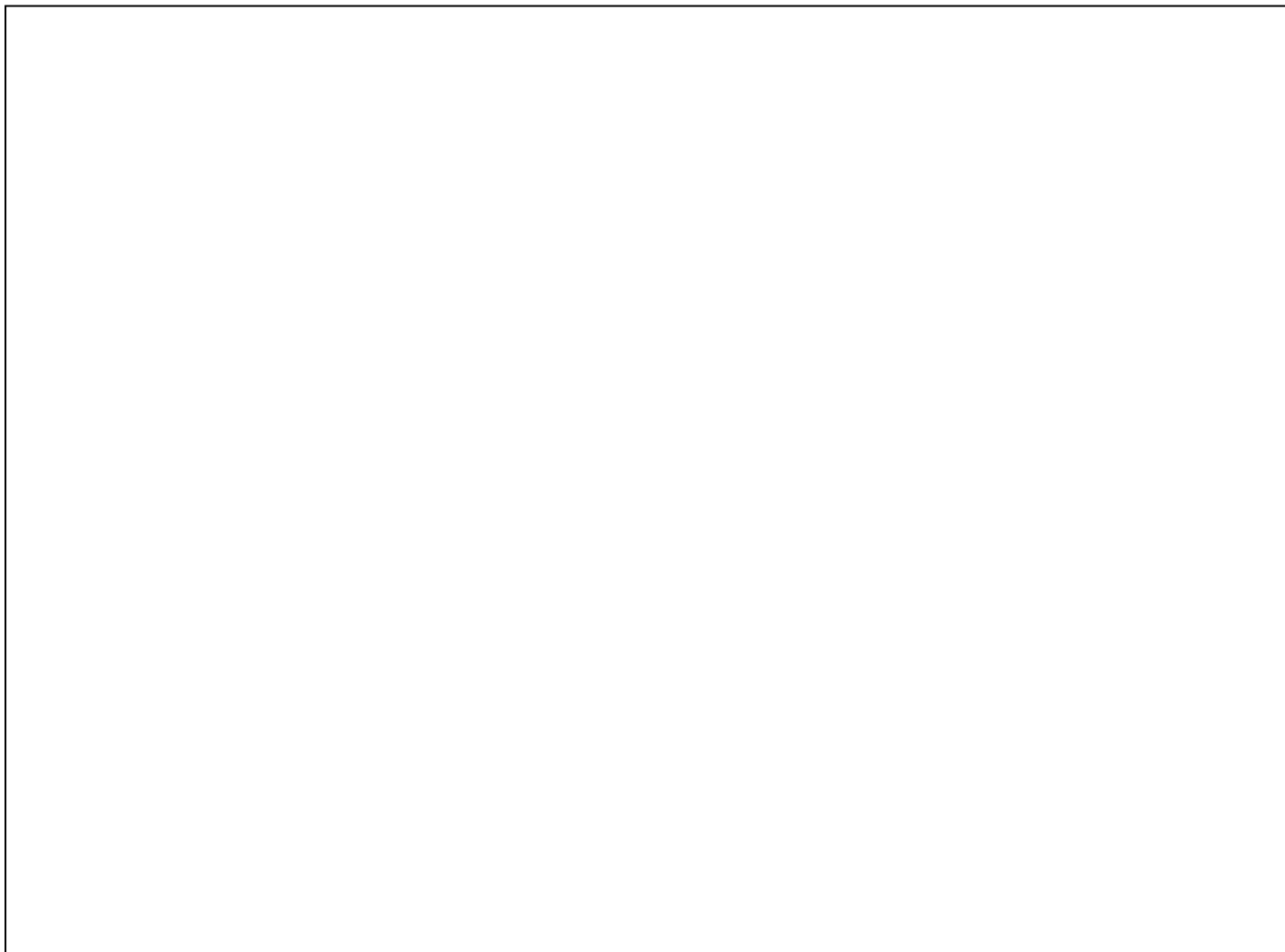

SCHOOL REGULATIONS

1. A non-refundable deposit of US \$400 must accompany any applications for admission.
2. The headmaster's decision in any matter concerning admission and placement of a child in a particular class in final.
3. School fees are due termly on or before the first day of term and late fees will be subject to late payment charges. Dishonoured cheques will be subject to a 10% penalty.
4. The school reserves the right to increase the fees upon giving a three months notice in writing.
5. Three months notice in writing is required if a child is to be withdrawn from the school. Where such notice is received the caution deposit, less the cost of lost or damaged property will be refunded.
6. All items of clothing and personal property should be clearly marked with the child's name. The school accepts no responsibility for lost property.
7. An explanatory letter is required in cases of absence from school or for non-attendance at PE or swimming lessons. A doctor's letter is required if there are medical reasons for non attendance at PE or swimming lessons The school takes no responsibility for incidents arising for failure to notify it as stated herein.
8. The school accepts no responsibility for children left on the school premises before 7.45 a.m. or after 4.15 p.m.
9. Parents are welcome to visit the school at any time, but are encouraged to make an appointment if they wish to meet with a specific member of staff and they must report to reception on arrival.
10. Any child needing to leave the premises during school hours must have written permission from a parent/guardian and must obtain a gate pass from the relevant staff member.
11. Parents/guardians are expected to support the school administration as requested concerning all matters regarding the discipline of their child, but the school reserves the right to terminate, dismiss, suspend or discipline a student.
12. The school covers all students with Personal Accident Insurance. The school's liability regarding Personal Accident on the school grounds and on school trips does not extend beyond submitting claims on the student's behalf. Parents may wish to take out Additional Personal Accident cover for their child (ren).
13. Should a child be selected for sports squads, or to take part in activities such as concerts or drama productions, outside normal school hours, parents/guardians are expected to make every effort to make their child available.
14. When wearing the R.I.S.U uniform in public places, even when out of school hours and not on a school authorised activity, students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that is in accordance with the rules and regulations of R.I.S.U and that, at all times, upholds the good reputation of R.I.S.U.
15. Unless explicit written request to the contrary is received beforehand from the parents/guardians, your child may appear in photographs for RISU's advertising purposes. However, your child's name will not appear with any such photos or in an advertising literature without the prior consent being sought from the parents/guardian.
